KS2 Outdoor Adventure

Swan Class are going to be taking part in outdoor learning which is an intensive programme of literacy and numeracy on Thursday afternoons. During the sessions your child will have an opportunity to develop educational resilience, new learning opportunities which can then be developed further in the classroom setting, as well as physical development.

We will be leaving school during **Thursday** lunchtimes and will return to school by 3.15pm, starting on the 6th June until the 11th July (there will be no outdoor learning on the 4th July due to transition visits at Secondary schools) and will return to school by 3.15pm.

On the 11th July it will be half of the class as the other half will be taking part in year six afternoon teas, we will advise you if your child is going to outdoor learning on this day. **Children will need to bring along warm clothes, boots or wellies and a waterproof coat to change into at lunchtime during each session.** If the weather is good, sun cream might be useful.

This is an exciting opportunity for your child and we hope that it will an enjoyable and inspiring experience. The sessions take place at Ashenbank Wood, further details are available on the Woodland Trust website about the wood. In addition, please note that Swan class will be having swimming lessons at Strood Swimming pool next term starting on Wednesday 5th June. Please provide towel, goggles, swimming hat and a swimming costume/tight fitting trunks. Hats are available from the school office.
