Wellbeing – Relaxation Activity

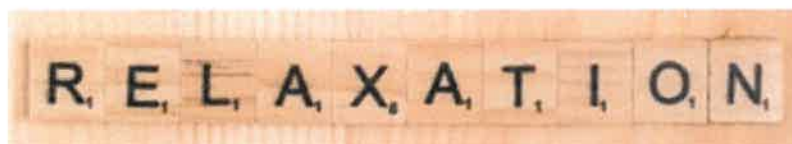
Feather/Statue
