On Wednesday 15 June, Robin and Magpie Classes will be attending (please can all children bring packed lunches and a drink).

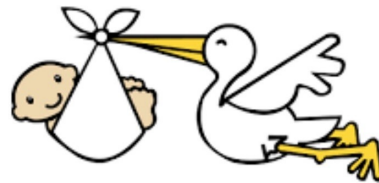
On Friday 17 June, Nightingale and Heron Classes will be attending—again please bring packed lunch.
