Home Learning and Spellings...

In Swan Class, children are given homework once a week, on a Friday; to be completed over the weekend. Homework should not take more than 20-30 minutes to complete. The idea is to reinforce work done in class, as well as prepare children for the move to secondary school. Please encourage your children to do the homework. Children unable to complete the homework are asked to stay in at break time to finish it.

Whilst there is no weekly spelling test in Swan Class, the children take part in a daily activity around a specific spelling rule. The approach is to immerse the children in the vocabulary and origin of words, in order to help them recall the rules.


Reading...
