
This year our themes will be Reading Gives you Wings, Castles and Knights, To the Moon, Out of Africa, From Plot to Plate.

Reading

Reading and being read to are the most important things you can do with your child and this should be done daily. Make reading interactive by asking questions about the story as well as making predictions about what might happen next.

Reading books are set via Bug Club, children will have one book a week online which will be updated on a Friday. We encourage sharing of other texts that your children enjoy at home regularly.

Children will receive a 'bug' on a chart in class each time that they read their bug club book. There will be rewards given, relative to the number of bugs collected in a term.
