I love maths and get very excited when teaching it.

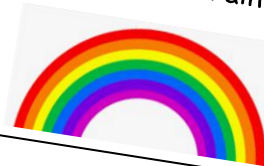


I'm Miss Wright, I will be helping in your class every day.
