<u>Task 1</u> <u>If I was a Knight for the day..</u>	Can you write a diary entry about your day as a knight? What adjectives could you use to describe your day? How do you feel to be a knight? If you could do anything as a knight what would you do? What was your favourite part about being a knight?
<u>Task 2</u> <u>Castle information page</u>	What do you know about castles? Make an information page to tell us more about what castles were like. You may like to draw and label a castle or write a fact page with diagrams. Make your page as interesting and colourful as possible.
<u>Task 3</u> <u>Design, label and describe your dream castle</u>	What would your dream castle look like? How big would it be? what colour would you want it to be? Which features would it have? Be as imaginative as possible. Draw your dream castle, label its key features and write a description to tell us more about it.
<u>Task 4</u> <u>Family Talk Time</u>	Discuss with your family the following question. If you were going to build a castle where would you build it and why?
