
Term 3 - Off We Go!

We hope that your family had a fantastic Christmas break and your child is feeling recharged and ready for the term ahead. We are very excited about this term's theme which is called "Off We Go!" and we have planned lots of learning activities linked to journeys and different modes of transport.



Each week, whilst the children are learning from home, we will create 'My Learning Challenges' and a 'Phonics 5' plan and publish these on our EYFS

webpage. The activities are suggestions and to act as a guide, feel free to adapt these to suit your child and to the resources you have at home. Your child should already have their Matheletics and Purple Mash login details and we would encourage them to use these online learning resources whilst they are at home. Each week we will be setting some '2dos' on Purple Mash that your child can complete and we will be checking Purple Mash regularly and responding back to work that the children save on here.



We begin the term by looking at journeys we make on foot and thinking about vehicles we see on the road. In the first week, we will be looking at the book 'Rosie's Walk', a beautifully illustrated story written by Pat Hutchins. Throughout the term, we will be linking our learning to a number of journey themed stories including 'Handa's Surprise', 'Mr Gumpy's Outing' and 'The Train Ride'. 'Space' is always a popular theme with our Reception children and so

nearer the end of the term we will also be looking at the story 'Whatever Next'. We had planned to have a Space themed dress up day in the last week of term to celebrate and finish our theme and we are hoping that the current situation will have changed so that we will still be able to enjoy this day together. On page 2, you will find an outline of what we hope to cover through our theme 'Off We Go!' this term.

Develop independent writing - captions and short sentences.
