







Week 2: Theme 'To the moon'

Some activities for you to complete this week alongside English, Maths, Phonics & Guided Reading

<p>PSHE - Jigsaw</p> <p>This week we are thinking about setting ourselves some goals and this might be tricky sometimes. What is a goal? It's not just in football but we have them in our lives, sometimes people set them or we set our own. Think of your difference makers and how your teachers have set up things they would like you to try and achieve. These are goals, now can you set yourself some for this term. It might be to try and complete all your remote learning each day, or making sure you read a book or go for a walk. Can you draw them and then write the material it is made of?
