

## Read it

Play Phonics Boogie.

Ask an adult to write some words on pieces of paper and scatter them face down on the floor. Play some music and get dancing! When the music stops, choose a piece of paper, turn it over and read the word. Repeat until all the words have been read.

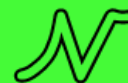
Example real and alien words you could use: vat, tav, vet, vis, lev, sav, vig, vud.



## Write it

Pour a layer of rice into a baking tray or similar. Practise forming the letter v in the foam saying this 'letter talk' as you do:

'Whoosh, vulture - down a wing and up a wing.'



Once you have practised forming the letter v ask an adult to call out some simple words for you to write in your foam. Remember to carefully segment (break down) each word into the sounds you can hear then write it in your foam. Suggested words: van, vet, pen, rat, tap, fan.

Ask an adult to help write some words onto paper and place them around the house. Using a paper plate (or similar) as a steering wheel, drive your van to collect a piece of paper and read the word. Keep driving until you have collected and read all of the words.

Suggested words: jam, visit, jump, vet, jot, vat, jug, van, jog.

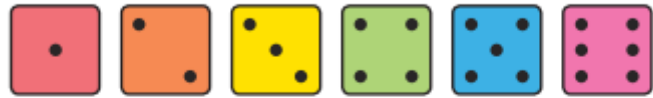

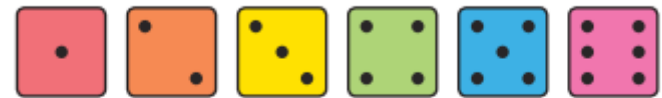
