SCHOOL PHOTOGRAPHS

Individual school photos are being taken in school on Thursday 2nd November. Your child will bring home a card with a code for you to view and order photos if you wish. Sibling photos for children in school will be taken on Friday 3rd November.

We are asking if it is possible for younger siblings (not currently at school) to be photographed early each of these mornings prior to school starting. We will let you know if we are able to do this.

HOMEWORK

At our parent forum it was mentioned that homework expectations are not clear and consistent between classes. We will send out further information next term, which will be age specific. The most important homework for primary aged pupils is reading. Children should be reading aloud to an adult every single day throughout primary school, even in KS2 when they may have the capacity to read in their head. This will improve their fluency and reading speed. Furthermore, it enables the adult to know what has been read and ask questions to develop their comprehension. Rote learning will also form a part of our homework, including timetables and spelling of irregular (common exception) words which need to be learnt by sight.

SWIMMING



Swimming this year is for Year 3. This is to enable them to get a substantial amounts of lessons to enable them to learn to swim. In previous years all children have gone on 6 week blocks but this doesn't give us enough time to teach swimming effectively.

We have requested a voluntary payment of £1 per week for swimming for each year 3 pupil (£17 requested) so far we have only received £272.00 which equates to 16 children out of 60. Please note that school has to pay for the swimming lessons/teachers and the transport so any help with this would be much appreciated. Thank you for your support.

<u>UNIFORM</u>

Reminder that we only have a limited amount of uniform left at school—you can see what is available at www.eduspot.co.uk by going under the shop section.



When this has run out the uniform will only be sold at Uniform base in Chatham. You can visit the shop, order on their website or call them to order. If you want purchases sent to school free, ask them to hold it and send in bulk with other parental orders to school.

EXPECTATIONS

We expect children to be wearing the correct school uniform at all times. On P.E days this will include a school P.E t-shirt and dark shorts or tracksuit bottoms with the school jumper. We do not want to see hoodies or named sportswear. We are looking into purchasing some school fleeces for the colder months.

For outdoor learning and Forest school we have asked that the children wear old clothes, wherever possible we would asked that these are plain and not emblazoned with sports or designer motifs. If your child is not dressed appropriately you will be contacted by the class teacher and they may be changed into some of our more suitable spare clothes.

Children with long hair must have their hair tided back and children should not be wearing jewellery apart from plain stud earrings and a simple watch. If children have their ears pierced they should be able to take the earrings out. The school have previously allowed children to tape their ears for P.E. From January 1st 2024 this will no longer be our school policy. Therefore, we would ask that children's ears are only pierced at the start of the school summer holiday so they are fully healed and can be taken in and out by the time they are back in school.
