





PRACTISE SPELLINGS

- To practise your spellings we will use the look write say cover write check game:
 - First look at the word and read it 3 times.
 - Second write the word 3 times.
 - Then spell the word out loud 3 times.
 - After that cover and write the word without looking.
 - Finally check to see if you got it right.
- You can choose a few words each day from the list on the right and then test yourself at the end of the week.
 Don't worry if you get some wrong we are still learning.

Spelling rule: The short 'u' sound is spelled with the letter 'o'. Often before a 'th', 'v' or 'n'.
