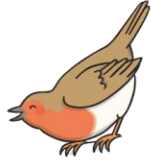


Robin Class

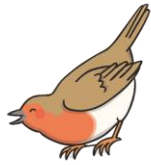
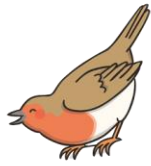


Our Working Week

- A class story

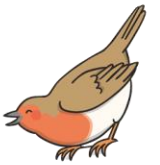
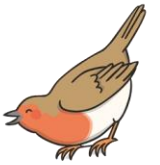


PE and Outdoor Learning

Whilst our PE lessons are timetabled for specific days, sometimes this may change and therefore children need to have their full PE kit in school each day.

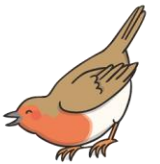
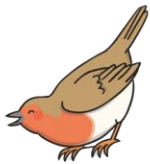
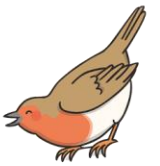

Reading

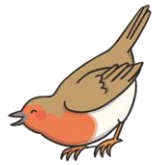


- We would really love every child in Robin Class to read aloud daily to an adult. This can be recorded in their reading record with any comments. We are really focusing on asking questions to check the children's understanding of what they have read; asking your child simple questions about what you have read together would certainly help this.
- We expect children to bring in their reading books and reading records into class every morning as this will enable us to see how often they read as well as reply to any notes you may have written.



Rewards

- In Robin Class, exceptional effort is rewarded
- We use class dojo points daily to recognise hard work, for helping a peer and contributions to lessons that make us say WOW!
- Two children with the most class dojo points at the end of the week will be able to pick a prize from the treat box.
- We also run a reading reward challenge where the children who read three times a week, each week will receive a prize at the end of each term. There are a range of prizes that include additional golden time, laptop free time as well as sweet treats.
