Daily routines...

Everyday Swan class enjoy the following

- ✓ Green time (10 minutes reward time for all children who have had a 'green' day.)


P.E. ...

Our P.E slots vary throughout the week, these will both inside and outside, so children are allowed to have tracksuit bottoms and a hoodie/ jumper for the winter months. We would ask that you ensure that your child has their full PE Kit in school every day.

Home Learning...

In Swan Class, children are given homework once a week, on a Friday; to be completed over the weekend. Homework should not take more than 20-30 minutes to complete. Homework is due in on Tuesdays and the idea is to reinforce work done in class, as well as prepare children for the move to secondary school. Please encourage your children to do the homework. Children who are unable to complete the homework will miss a green time and will be given the opportunity to complete it.

Reading...




There is an opportunity for children to read every day. They are encouraged to read a variety of genres, and a record is kept of their book choices to enable us to monitor this. Please do your best to encourage your child to read for pleasure at home on a daily basis. It is important to still read with your child and hear them read; just because they can read fluently, doesn't mean they shouldn't still read to you regularly!

Rewards...

Swan Class earn Dojo points through work in lessons as well as participation, and behaviour in and around school. At the end of each week the person with the most Dojo's will get a prize.



Consequences...



In Swan class, we use a behaviour traffic light system to make sure everyones follows the rules and expectations of the classroom. All children start on green each day and if they remain on green they have earned 'green time' at the end of each day. If they make the wrong choices their name is moved down the traffic light system – yellow means they miss 5 minutes of their green time that day, orange they miss all their green time that day and red they miss their green time and there are further consequences such as removal from class or lost breaktimes the next day. This system is in place so that we can all do our best, we are all kept safe and ready to learn.
