
YEAR 2 – WEEK 2 THEME LEARNING

Monday – Geography

Tuesday – Art


This term in art we are going to be looking at African prints and patterns.


- Have a look at the pictures of the African fabrics and patterns, there are lots in Mr Trevallion's bunting. What do you notice about the patterns? Can you see any shapes, lines, colours or textures?
- African prints are very bright and colourful so today in art you are going to focus on colour.
- We have 3 primary colours red, blue and yellow.
- We then also have 3 secondary colours which are green, purple and orange.
- The secondary colours are made by mixing two primary colours together. Can you remember how?
- Task can you make a colour wheel to show all the colours (look at the example on the right). If you have some paints you may also like to paint the process you would use to make the different colours.
- Challenge: how can we make the colours lighter or darker?


